Grade Point Average

Other Final Notations

Grade	Grade Code	Descriptor
Withdrawn Deleted	WD	The student has withdrawn from the subject without financial or academic penalty.
Withdrawn Not Fail	WNF	The student has withdrawn from the subject without academic penalty.
Withdrawn Fail	WF	The student has withdrawn from the subject after the academic withdrawal date but on or before the withdrawal deadline. The student withdrew from the subject with academic and financial penalties.
Credit Transfer	CT	The student has achieved all of the learning outcomes specified for the subject to the required standard through prior formal learning.
Recognition of Prior Learning	RPL	The student has achieved all of the learning outcomes specified for that subject to the required standard through prior learning that includes informal and/or non-formal learning, and may also include formal learning.
